

## Connect the dots!

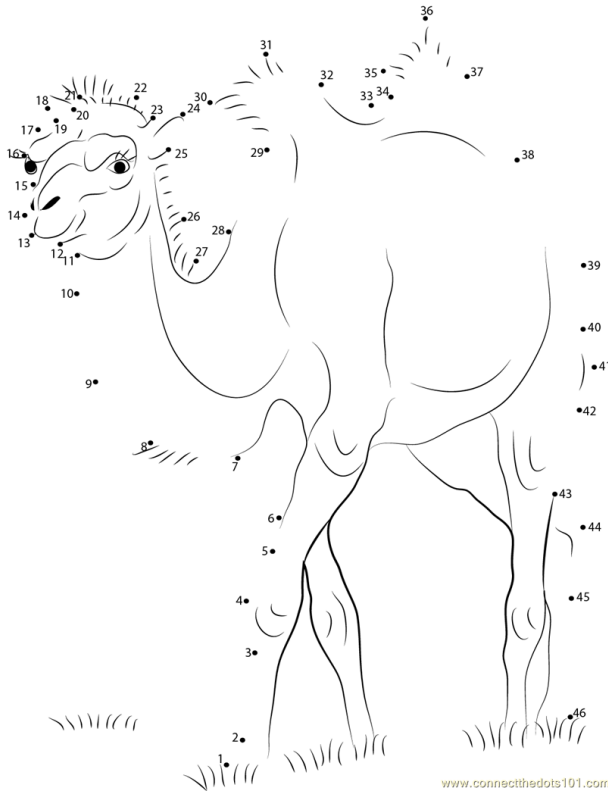
Did you know that adult camels have wide mouths that can fit a human head!

Camels who are excited may huff so sharply that they often spit. They may even regurgitate their food and throw up on people if they feel threatened.

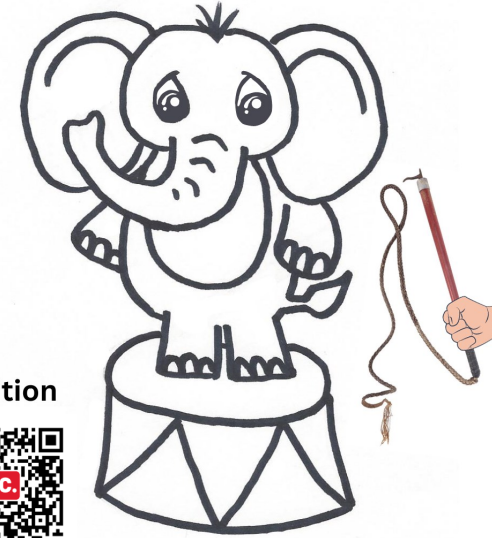
Camel families can consist of as many as 100 members, but generally consist of 2-15 in the herd.

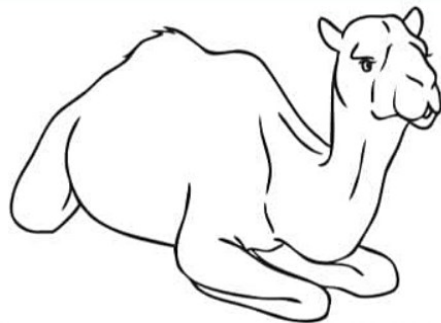


Circus animals travel at least 9 months of the year in cramped quarters and in all kinds of weather. When they are not performing, they spend their time chained or in cages. They suffer like this just to provide us with “entertainment.”

Pat Derby, an animal trainer for 20 years, states: “No captive wild animal will perform on cue out of love, only out of constantly reinforced fear. An enormous amount of pain and suffering is required to obtain the tricks these animals perform.” Look for the tools they use —bull hooks and whips.

Many of the tricks the animals perform are unnatural, physically uncomfortable, and can cause serious injuries.

Please choose circuses that do not use animals, like The Pickle Family Circus and Cirque de Soleil, or visit vegan sanctuaries.
